**Description:** The goal of this workshop is to work together within a group of other students to construct a small miniature set that is appropriate for the production of a stop motion animated film. Students will be guided through the process from design to fabrication to filming by the instructor over the course of 3 days. We will use the Film Department's new Stop Motion facility in ed133.4 which includes a dedicated lighting grid, camera motion control system and Dragonframe animation software.
